Using Drones to Survey Landscapes - Gowrie Creek from Above, Tuesday, 18 June 2019



A community interest event, supported by Toowoomba Regional Council and Householders' Options to Protect the Environment (HOPE), is being held to provide an aerial perspective of Gowrie Creek from the Water Treatment Plant to the tree plantation in west Gowrie Junction. Gowrie Creek was flown with a drone at a height of 30m with the occasional rise to 50m. This provides a unique perspective of the creek and will interest local residents with a chance to see the creek from above and ask questions about the creeks condition.

This community event is free and will be held on **Tuesday 18th June March** in the Gowrie State School Resource Centre starting at 7pm and finishing at 9pm. A light supper will be provided mid event.

The presenter will be Steve Cupitt from Crossroads Rural & Environment. Steve is an environmental scientist and drone operator. Steve will be supported by Frank Ondrus, President of HOPE.

Come along to have a look at "Gowrie Creek from above", see if you can spot your house and ask Steve about the issues you think may be facing the creek.
