- Provision of free drone fly-overs: Friends of the Escarpment Parks (FEP)Toowoomba Redwood Park re Cats Claw Creeper infestation; and Coalbank Road Reserve (Coalbank)
 - --- No response from FEP Toowoomba
- Renew Toowoomba has invited us to assist them in their <u>Community Partners</u> (<u>rewiringaustralia.org</u>) project.
 - --- awaiting more information from Renew Toowoomba
- Partnership with Ros Darracott, Associate Professor (Social Work and Human Services), UniSQ
 re: Eco-Social initiatives (see list elsewhere)
 - --- awaiting further contact from Ros Darracott
- Funding opportunity Ergon Energy Community Fund Program: We could apply for funding to build another 150 nesting boxes. What do YOU THINK?
 - --- Yes, we'll go again with another nest box project. Frank will seek expressions of interest from Catholic schools and churches; and Land for Wildlife landholders.
 - --- Frank will renegotiate terms with the Toowoomba West Men's Shed (TWMS) before making a grant application. Grant application must be submitted by 24 Nov 2024.

Other matters

- Review value of current Alliances/Partnerships. What about working with Biodynamic Agriculture Australia Ltd, Transition Australia and Community Gardens Australia?
 - --- Questions posed include Who should we align with? How are other NFPs dealing with memberships, etc?
- Government environment meetings and/or groups what are they doing that we could consider?
- Undertake more networking especially with younger people → e.g. UniSQ media students
- Do more regular 'issue-based' ZOOM interviews through to podcasts, For example, interviewing our Patron – Jerry Coleby-Williams and his interests in gardening, etc.
 - Review Andrew's earlier work on addressing 'system level problems'
 - Review our <u>alliances</u> to undertake 'on the ground' projects that are outcome based such as climate change and physical health. Anna volunteered to reach out to allied charities for an update on current work being undertaken to review HOPE's membership in these groups.

- Working with UniSQ eco-social work students and local groups such as community gardens
- Backup options for secondary members to complete podcasts etc. (HOPE members to be trained on podcasts etc. – everyone to have a secondary member as a backup?). Charmaine?
