The premiere screening of *Climate Changers* was at the Sydney Film Festival in 2023. Directed by Johan Gabrielsson, and written and produced by Mark Forstmann, *Climate Changers* follows acclaimed scientist Tim Flannery as he searches for the missing ingredient in our fight against climate change – leadership.

on the Hawkesbury River, to the world's largest global climate summit, I witnessed his amazing knowledge and empathy on full display. I hope **Climate Changers** offers inspiration and impetus to a greener tomorrow."
