**Re: World Environment Day and Logan Eco Action Festival (LEAF)**

World Environment Day 2026 will take place on Friday, 5 June, with this year's theme centred on reimagining how we think about the systems that underpin our economies and repairing our relationship with the climate in ways that go beyond only reducing carbon emissions. Established by the UN General Assembly in 1972, World Environment Day serves as an annual reminder for people worldwide to consider how they can contribute to the betterment of our physical environment.

This year's global observance is hosted in Baku, the capital city of the Republic of Azerbaijan, with related events and activities taking place worldwide. One such event is the annual Logan Eco Action Festival (LEAF), scheduled for Sunday, 7 June 2026 at Griffith University (Logan Campus), 68 University Drive, Meadowbrook, Queensland.

Householders' Options to Protect the Environment (HOPE) Inc. (Australia) will be attending LEAF this year, hosting an information display as part of our efforts to build support and connect with the community. HOPE aims to be a voice within local environmentally conscious networks, highlighting the power of individuals coming together to influence our collective climate trajectory.

LEAF is the City of Logan's largest environmental event, with this year's event set to host leading sustainability experts and conservationists who will be delivering interactive workshops and insightful talks. Fun, free and family-friendly, this all-ages event provides a valuable opportunity for householders and individuals alike to learn how they can minimise their environmental impact, both individually and within their broader networks.

Highlights of the day include live music performances, eco-market stalls, food vendors, the thrifty Logan Wardrobe Rummage, and HOPE's information display centred on responsible and sustainable environmental stewardship. Attending LEAF 2026 is the perfect way to engage with World Environment Day 2026, as the event is closely aligned with this year's United Nations (UN) theme.


Come along to connect with like-minded communities, learn from top environmental experts, and don't forget to pick up your free native plant.
