# Minutes of 2<sup>nd</sup> Ordinary Meeting – Saturday, 10 February 2024

## 5. Corr in:

Steady stream of daily e: mail correspondence – junk mail jettisoned; other correspondence vetted and onforwarded to - specific office bearers; other key stakeholders; media; and the occasional global email to members & supporters.

- Letters from Australian Tax Office (ATO) advising us that they are now responsible for Deductible Gift Recipient (DGR) matters
  - → As a result of the changes to the *Treasury Laws Amendment Act 2023*, from 1 January 2024 the responsibility for the DGR has moved to the ATO and the Register of Environmental Organisations (REO) has been dissolved.
  - The ATO has slightly different rules for who can be a DGR. I have checked their requirements, but nothing has changed for HOPE.
  - As the REO no longer exists, we do not have to submit any further statistical returns each year. We do still have to do a tax return as usual as well as fulfil the ACNC requirements.
  - We must ensure that our incorporation documents are in line with the new law. This involves the winding up provisions and the Public Fund in particular:
    - The winding up provisions must deal with where any funds will go (if there are any) in the case of HOPE folding. We have to "transfer all remaining bits, deductible contributions and money received in relation to such gifts and contributions to a gift deductible fund, authority or institution". I believe that this is what HOPE's constitution states, so we don't need to change it.
    - Under the ATO rules, the Public Fund is now known as a Gift Fund. Any receipts we issue must be in the name of the organisation rather than the public fund. I haven't seen the most recent version of the receipt to check what it says. May require a small change to the template to ensure compliance.
  - We should remove any references in any documentation we have (including digitally, such as the website) to the Department of Environment and (being listed on) the REO. We are not obliged to

change this in the constitution, unless we have to amend the constitution anyway. Next time it needs updating, we need to change these references.

- HOPE must "have a policy of not acting as a mere conduit for the donation of money or property to other organisations, bodies or persons". This can be put on the website, in the constitution (I haven't checked to see if it says this), on receipts and/or in a separate document. One of these is sufficient.
- We have to notify the ATO if there are any changes to key personnel, structure and activities, and winding up the organisation (like we would with the ACNC).
