Key Principles of a Sustainable Home

1 Smart Design & Orientation

Positioning homes to maximize sunlight and airflow, reducing energy demand.

- Living areas facing north (in Australia)
- Natural ventilation and cross-breezes
- Shading to block summer heat

Good design can reduce overall energy use and demand

2 Passive Heating & Cooling

Use nature, not machines, to maintain comfortable indoor temperatures.

- Insulation, shading, ventilation
- Thermal mass materials
- Window placement and glazing

Thoughtful design can maintain comfortable indoor temperatures.

2 Energy Efficiency

Use less energy through efficient systems and renewable sources.

- Energy-efficient appliances
- LED lighting
- Solar and renewable systems

Efficient homes help lower energy costs and reduce emissions over time.

4 Water Efficiency

Design homes to conserve and manage water effectively.

- Water-efficient fixtures
- Rainwater tanks
- Smart landscaping

Smart design can reduce resource use and minimise waste.

5 Materials & Environment

Select materials and design approaches that minimise environmental impact.

- Recycled and local materials
- Low-toxicity and durable design
- Protect vegetation and biodiversity

Responsible design can supports healthier ecosystems and homes.

6 Healthy & Inclusive Living

Create homes that are safe, comfortable, and adaptable for all.

- Natural light and ventilation
- Safe and accessible design
- Flexible living spaces
